### OTHER COMPONENTS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION TO THINK ABOUT:

- An essay on a topic relevant to the scholarship purpose
- A list of academic and/or non-academic awards and achievements.
- A description of extra-curricular involvement
- An explanation of financial need
- Copies of high school and/or college transcripts
- Letters of recommendation from teachers, advisors, employers, etc.
