RE: Nebraska 2019 Legislative Session, Week ending May 10, 2019

WEEK IN REVIEW

Today was the 74th day of the 90-day 2019 legislative session. This week the legislature conducted full day debates of revenue and budget measures along with selected Senator, Committee, and Speaker Priority bills.

This mainline budget was advanced from General File. The Two year budget package sets state spending at \$9.3 billion with an average spending growth rate of 3%.

The main revenue bill proposed to reduce property taxes LB289, by Sen. Linehan to “Change provisions relating to county assessor inspections of real property for property tax purposes”. LB289 was debated at length. An amendment to LB289 replaced the bill and it would increase the state sales tax from 5/5% to 6.0% beginning July, 2019, and imposing sales tax on bottled water, candy, soft drinks, and increase the cigarette tax from 64 cents to \$1, and impose taxes on about 20 services, and eliminate other exemptions. Per the Speaker’s agenda practice, Sen. Linehan must demonstrate that at least 33 supporters for LB289 before it will be scheduled for further debate.

The failure of LB289 to advance prompted Sen. Linehan to seek and achieve an amendment to LB298 then mainline budget bill. Sen. Linehan’s amendment included a general fund transfer of \$51 million in each of the next two fiscal years to the property tax relief from the cash reserve. This was adopted and the bill advanced.

The proponents of increasing the sales tax on food products, cigarettes and services are discussing further steps to raise additional revenue for property tax relief.

On Tuesday, May 7th LB 418 by Senator Cavanaugh to “Change provisions under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act and change provisions relating to tort claims against the state, the State Self-Insured Liability Fund, and state vehicles” passed on Final Reading to go to the Governor’s desk for his signature.

LB672 ANTI by Senator Clements to “Change provisions of the Motor Vehicle Registration Act relating to a named driver insurance policy” has not advanced from the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee.

We are preparing presentations regarding LB139 PRO by Senator Kolterman to “Change provisions relating to a data base of contractors under the Contractor Registration Act”. LB139 has been signed by the Governor. IIAN is offering continuing education regarding LB139 on May 21st in Kearney, on May 22nd in Norfolk, and on May 23rd in Ashland (Mahoney State Park). We continue to work with the Department of Labor as they craft revisions to their contractor registration website.
