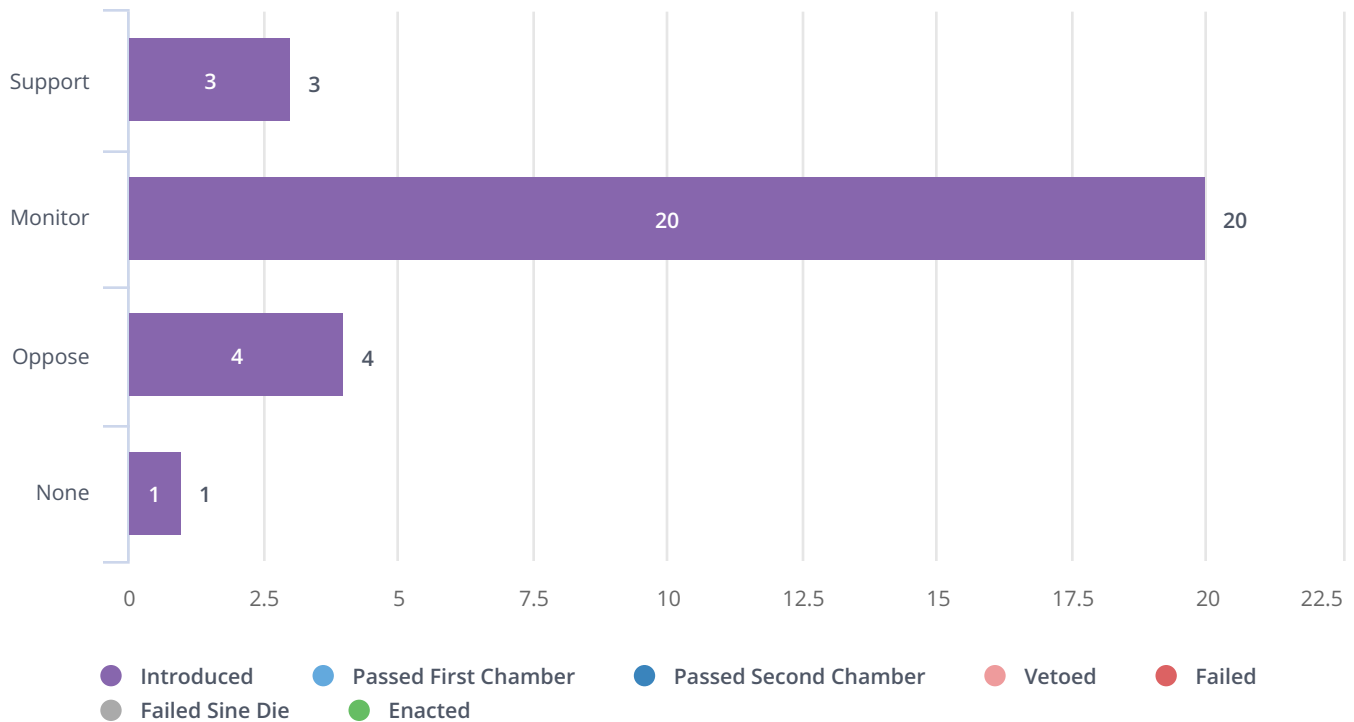

LB719 - Change provisions under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act relating to physicians, compensation, and benefits and require cost-of-living adjustments and payment for interpreter services

**Bill Summary:** Last edited by Perre Neilan at Jan 21, 2022, 9:03 PM  
Amends the original Workers' Compensation Act to include the provision of interpreter services at the employer's expense if the employee does not speak English or the language of the employer, examining physician or surgeon. Amends the percent of wages received for total and partial disability from 66 2/3 to 80 and 75 percent, respectively. Starting 1/23, allows for cost-of-living adjustments for benefits lasting longer than 12 months. The maximum weekly benefit shall be 200 percent and the minimum weekly benefit of 50 percent of the state's average weekly wage. Amends compensation to dependents and if no dependents.
