

Bill Summary: Last edited by Perre Neilan at Jan 21, 2022, 9:03 PM Amends the original Workers' Compensation Act to include the provision of interpreter services at the employer's expense if the employee does not speak English or the language of the employer, examining physician or surgeon. Amends the percent of wages received for total and partial disability from 66 2/3 to 80 and 75 percent, respectively. Starting 1/23, allows for cost-of-living adjustments for benefits lasting longer than 12 months. The maximum weekly benefit shall be 200 percent and the minimum weekly benefit of 50 percent of the state's average weekly wage. Amends compensation to dependents and if no dependents.

Adds group capital calculation instructions as adopted by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners. Adds definitions of NAIC Liquidity Stress Test Framework as well as scope criteria. Adds requirement of filing with registration an annual group capital calculation and specifies exemptions to such requirement. Adds information filed shall be maintained confidential, including proprietary and trade secret information. Prohibits NAIC or third-party consultant from storing any information. Defines how annual group capital calculation and resulting group capital ratios are to be used and makes it unlawful to divulge such information.

Amends that no landowner, tenant or landowner's agent where land-management burning occurs shall be held personally liable for damages caused by such burning, unless willful misconduct or gross negligence is evidenced. Fire chief or designee shall not be liable for damages due to issuing land-management permit. Adds land-management permit to be considered in the public interest and not a nuisance if conducted in accordance with the law or regulation.

Bill Summary: Last edited by Perre Neilan at Jan 21, 2022, 9:17 PM Defines primary credit source. Entitles the board of directors or committee to review or revise the written plan for making investments and engaging in investment practices annually. Changes the definition of acceptable collateral means. Redefines highly rated investments, repurchase transactions and reverse repurchase transactions. Adds language to reverse repurchase transaction for collateral and public equity securities. Defines when a security shall not be deemed to be foreign. Changes the amount of insurer's investments to not exceed 25 percent of admitted assets from 20. Changes regarding how an insurer may invest in bonds or notes secured by a first mortgage on leasehold estates in real estate. Changes the amount a life insurer may make in investments.
