RE: Nebraska 2020 Legislative Session, Week ending March 27, 2020

WEEK IN REVIEW

Thursday, March 12th was the 40th day of this short, 60-day session. The Legislature was expected to return for its 41st day on Tuesday, March 17th; however, on Monday, March 16th the Speaker suspended the session until further notice. Then on March 20th the Speaker reconvened the Unicameral for March 23rd to authorize emergency spending to address the coronavirus pandemic. By Wednesday, March 25th (43rd legislative day), LB1198e was passed by 45 affirmative votes, and signed by the Governor. Four Senators were excused because they are at high risk for the COVID-19 virus. Click here for Unicameral report on final bill provisions.

While the Senators waited for the Governor to return the signed LB1198e, the only other major business conducted during these three legislative days was that the Revenue Committee advanced to General File LB1106 to "Eliminate obsolete sales tax provisions" with Committee amendment AM2870 which fundamentally transformed LB1106 into the property tax relief effort of 2020. Importantly, LB1106 was advanced with two of the eight committee members still dissenting. The Committee Statement explains how the Committee's amendment AM2870 transforms LB1106 into the property tax relief bill. LB 1106 is Speaker Scheer's personal priority bill.

Since half of the body is up for the primary election on May 12th, Speaker Scheer announced before adjournment on March 23rd, that the earliest likely call back date is Monday, May18th. When called back, Senators will complete the remaining budget bills before any others, and the role of prioritized bills will be increased in the remaining 17 legislative days. We should expect an effort to fashion a forest of "Christmas tree" bills, since only bills that are prioritized and out of committee have any chance of making it to the Governor's desk.

For a quick summary of where the session was upon starting its long recess, here is a listing of the bills of special interest to IIAN that clearly still are in play, their position, and priority.

LB 944 by Senator Geist is on Final Reading and given a new one liner. LB 944 is now a Christmas tree with AM2307 adding the provisions of LB 768, LB 785, LB 831, LB 983, and LB 1067, none of which was being specifically followed by IIAN. The NEW ONE LINER is to "Change and provide provisions for REAL ID, motor vehicle fees, federal references, handicapped parking permits, junked vehicles, odometers, destroyed vehicles, the International Registration Plan, license plates,

electronic delivery of operator's licenses and ID cards, CDL's, point system, vehicle length and weight limits; ATV's and UTV's, the International Tax Agreement Act, the unified carrier registration plan and agreement, and civil penalties". The OLD ONE LINER was to "Change provisions relating to motor vehicles". Transportation & Telecommunications Committee priority.

LB 963 is on Final Reading - introduced by Senator Brewer to "Change provisions relating to workers' compensation for injuries to first responders and frontline state employees." On Select File LB963 had amended into it (AM2734) provisions/portions of LB448 to "Change provisions relating to compensation for burial expenses under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act". Senator McDonnell priority.

LB774 is on Select File - started as the Insurance Department's bill, was given a new one liner: "Change provisions relating to reinsurance, motor vehicle service contract reimbursement insurance, and fees for dental services and prohibit certain activities by health care facilities"; the OLD ONE LINER was to "Change requirements regarding credit for reinsurance". With the committee amendment AM2558, LB774 became a Christmas tree that contains provisions of three other bills (none of which was being specifically followed by IIAN): LB886 by Senator Arch to "Prohibit certain acts by health insurers and network providers and list a deceptive trade practice"; LB954 by Senator Lindstrom to "Change insurance provisions relating to fees for dental services"; and LB1199 by Senator Lindstrom to "Change provisions relating to motor vehicle service contract reimbursement insurance". Banking, Commerce & Insurance Committee priority.

Interesting note regarding LB 746 and the California Consumer Privacy Act:

LB746 (Monitor) was introduced this year by Senator Blood, to Adopt the Nebraska Consumer Data Privacy Act (a version of the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA)). LB746 is stalled in the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee and is not prioritized. But note, the first case involving CCPA has reached the California courts as reported by LexBlog (3/24, Poston). On March 9, plaintiffs in a putative data-breach class action "filed an amended complaint against Hanna Andersson and Salesforce, its e-commerce platform, alleging a claim for violation of the CCPA." The amended complaint "alleges hackers scraped personally identifiable information (PII) from Andersson's and Salesforce's platform from September 16, 2019, to November 11, 2019, and used that information to steal the customers' identities and make fraudulent purchases." The complaint "presents a host of novel issues that courts will grapple with as the CCPA makes it way through the judiciary." Exclusions in LB 746 as introduced, would likely apply to IIAN member agencies.
